<p>The rise of cotton</p>	<p>Invention of cotton gin + expansion of textile mills in Europe=cotton explosion 6,000 bales (1790) 100,000 bales (1801), 2 million in 1840, and 4 million in 1860</p> <p>+ Effect=southern debts paid off, capitals are increased, land triples in value</p> <p>-Effect=slavery, between 1820-1850 the number of enslaved people rose from 1.5 million to 4 million</p> <p>South relies on agriculture, less than 16% of income from industry</p> <p>Southern class structure, starting with elite wealthy plantation owners</p>
<p>Nat Turner (Aug. 22, 1831)</p>	<p>Led an uprising in VA</p>
<p>Missouri Compromise</p>	<p>1819 the Union consisted of 11 free and 11 slave states</p> <p>House more northerners, MO wants in as a slave state James Tallmadge (NY)</p> <p>1) no new slaves into Missouri</p> <p>2) all enslaved children currently living in MO to be freed at age 25</p> <p>House approves senate rejects</p> <p>ME wants in as a free state, Sen. Jesse Thomas of IL, prohibit slavery in the LA purchase north of MO's southern border, pp. 213 picture</p>
<p>Election of 1824 (Favorite Sons Election)</p>	<p>Henry Clay—KY (West), Andrew Jackson—TN (West and War Hero), John Quincy Adams—MA, William Crawford (GA)—South</p>
<p>American System</p>	<p>Henry Clay—1)National Bank, protective tariff, nationwide internal improvements</p> <p>Jackson wins popular vote but no majority, Clay finishes 4th and is eliminated but he is still speaker of the House</p>
<p>Corrupt Bargain</p>	<p>Clay supports Adams, Adams wins and appoints Clay as Secretary of State, Jackson feels cheated=National Repub.</p>
